Message from the Headteacher

It might be because I'm getting older, but this year seems to be going faster than ever! Over the last term our pupils have achieved and been involved in so many great events, activities and learning opportunities. We have had several year groups going on trips and visits to places such as: Year 3 & 4 at Hazard Alley, Year 5 & 6 at Space Centre in Leicester, Year 2 went to Peterborough Museum, Reception had visit from Wood Green animal shelter, Year 2 and Year 3 participated in Sports and Athletics Festivals, the school choir participated with hundreds of schools at the Young Voices Singing event in Birmingham.

We have held our own special events in school including Science Week which was a fantastic week of activities, challenges and learning, and involved visitors into school to work with the children and the parents on science experiments! Fair Trade Fortnight which encourages children to learn and focus on protecting the planet and safeguarding the future of some of UKs foods as well as helping and understanding how farmers and workers in other countries get a fair deal. Red Nose Day, World Book Day, Buddy Morning, Child Mental Health Week and Safer Internet Day are some of the many other events which our school pupils have all participated in.

We have also continued our hard work and never-ending job of exploring and challenging ourselves as staff to ensure that we are constantly reviewing what we are doing and how we positively impact the learning and development of our pupils. We worked with external agencies and were put through a

mock 'Deep Dive' to review what we do with Science in our school. In previous terms we have had Maths and Reading carried out in the same way. I am very pleased to say that our science review day was a huge, positive success and helped confirm and reassure us that what we are doing in school is of a very high standard. The feedback we received was brilliant, and this included the work, attitudes and progress of our pupils! A special 'well done' to Mrs Bayliss and Miss Griffin, but also to everyone involved.

Similarly, we had a visit from our school improvement advisor who carried out a series of interviews with 12 staff to look at subject curriculum coverage and leadership, and also SEND and pupil attendance. These sessions were also hugely positive and complimentary, identifying and recognising the commitment and enthusiasm of our staff, and how our curriculum is sequenced, designed for our pupils, the logical progression and how we challenge and demonstrate high expectations of our pupils. Governors were recognised for the challenge they provide to leaders and how they monitor the curriculum delivery.

As always, a busy and very positive term which, over the last two weeks has seen our Year 4 and Year 5 children present their own year group's performance to parents, family and the school.

Thank you for your ongoing support, interest and enthusiasm in our school. I hope you and your children enjoy the Easter break. Children are back in school on **Monday 17th April** and we will update you on the many events taking place in the summer term.

Science Week

This term we saw the return of our fantastic Science Week!

We had a visit from The Royal Institute - the scientist presented a show to each Key Stage called 'Energy Live' which looks at different types of energy. All of the shows were jam-packed with experiments,

explosions and hands-on participation by the children, the scientist also presented an amazing show after school for parents and children.

Our years 5 and 6 enjoyed trips to The National Space Centre, where they got to create their own rockets to fly, see real space suits, climb the rocket tower and explore space in the UK's largest domed planetarium.

We had a visit from Wild Science who brought in some animals and reptiles for some of our year groups to see and touch.

All year groups took part in different scientific activities during the week including experiments based on 'The 3 little pigs', a recycled art competition, designing and creating a habitat within a box, dissecting owl pellets, and learning about evolution. All children also enjoyed the opportunity to come to school dressed as a scientist.

Mrs Bayliss also put on her gadget shop where the children were able to purchase fun science items and raffle tickets to win a bigger prize!

As you will be aware, The Hampton Parish Council have been running a competition for a Coronation design water bottle.


We are incredibly proud to say that both the winner *and* runner up were both Hampton Hargate Primary school pupils!

School Meals - Please remember to book your child's meal by midnight the day before they are required, children are not able to make a meal choice on the day, if no meal has been booked, they will only be able to be offered a jacket potato.

Can we also ask parents to please remember to cancel meals when not required. We will cancel meals for children who are absent or on a trip, however if you decide to send your child with a packed lunch instead or you know they will have an appointment over lunch, please cancel the booking made. If you need to cancel this on the day, please call us or email the office by 9:30am.

Between January and March, the kitchen made **495** meals that were not needed which has amounted to **£1237.50** and a large amount of food waste. The bill for this is paid for from the school budget and therefore has an impact on your child's education.


