School Grounds Reminders



- Please can we remind all visitors to the school to **NOT** push the front gate into the school grounds, this unfortunately causes the gate to break and is costly to repair, please ring the bell and wait for the gate to open for you, it is really important to keep this working properly to help keep the school grounds safe and secure.

Can we also ask parents to please remember to cancel meals when not required. We will cancel meals for children who are absent or on a trip, however if you decide to send your child with a packed lunch instead or you know they will have an appointment over lunch, please cancel the booking made. If you need to cancel this on the day, please call us or email the office by 9:30am.

Since January the kitchen has made over **£1000** worth of food that has been booked by parent/carers, that was then not needed due to appointments or a packed lunch being brought in instead, this has also amounted to a large amount of food waste. The bill for this is paid for from the school budget and therefore has an impact on your child's education.

Over the term we have had a large amount of lost property including coats, cardigans and jumpers, bottles, snack boxes and more at the main entrance to the school.

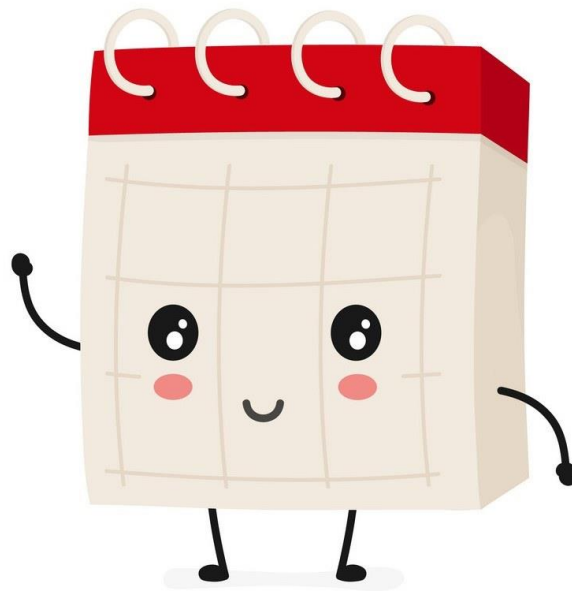
