RECEPTION SPRING AND SUMMER TERM VISITS/TRIPS

We have several extra curriculum events in the spring and summer term to look forward to, these events are to enhance your child's learning and we feel that they are a valuable part of the education we offer here at Hampton Hargate Primary School. These events have to be paid for from our school budget and your contributions are crucial to enabling us to continue to offer these events.

Tuesday 6th February – Recycling Education Team

We have already experienced a visit from The Recycling Education Team from Peterborough City Council. The children had the opportunity to explore recycling and find out which materials can be recycled. They loved asking questions about how to keep the world 'green' and what they can do to be good at recycling.

Monday 11th March- Friday 22nd March - Living Eggs

As part of our science enrichments in school we have an exciting opportunity to learn with first-hand experience from eggs to hatching of chicks in class. The children will experience life cycles and growth and development first hand, the opportunity encourages social interaction and promotes caring and nurturing skills.

Monday 25th March - Woodgreen 'Let's Talk About Pets' Workshop

Woodgreen Pets Charity will be delivering an exciting workshop where we will learn all about the work that they do, the types of pets that they help and how we should look after any pets we have. They will then introduce us to 'Henry Hamster' who will teach us what hamsters like/don't like and how we can care for them. This will link in with both our topic work on growing and changes and animals.

Thursday 4th July – Sacrewell Farm Visit

As part of our topic 'Animals' and 'Growing and Changes' Topics we have learnt about lots of different animals. During the day we will be completing various activities including carrying out a workshop and visiting the animals in their habitats. We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9:00am and get picked up from the Farm at 2:00pm. Children will need to wear their school uniform and bring a coat.

We will be having our lunch at Sacrewell Farm. If your child is having a packed lunch from home, they will need to bring this, a snack and a drink, in a named, disposable bag. Please ensure everything is disposable where possible.
