### **YEAR 1 Enrichment programme**

Year 1 have several extra curriculum events planned for the year. These events are to enhance your child's learning, and we feel they are valuable part of the education we offer here at Hampton Hargate Primary School. These events must be paid for from our school budget and your contributions are crucial to enabling us to continue to offer these events.

#### **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November – Recycling workshop**

The Recycling Education Team from Peterborough City Council will be coming in to school to carry out a workshop with the children. The children will have the opportunity to explore recycling and find out which materials can be recycled. Recycling Rita and Hungry Harry will also be in the workshops for the children to meet.

#### **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December – CSK Hampton Church**

As part of our RE learning, we will be walking to CSK Hampton church to learning all about Christingles and the importance of Christmas to Christians.

#### **Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> January– JuniorSTEM**

As part of our Computing and Design and Technology curriculum, the children will have the opportunity to take part in an exciting Lego Robotics workshop delivered by JuniorStem. The children will follow pictorial instructions and experiment with programming using the software Lego Wedo 2.0 software to create a moving robot.

#### **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January – Peterborough Museum**

The children will be visiting Peterborough Museum where they will learn about a large selection of toys dating back from Victorian times to the 1970s. This will link to our history topic work about toys from the past and our science work on materials. In this session they will find out what the toys are made from, how they work and how they compare to other toys within living memory. In addition to this, they will also have a go at making their own toy using a toy from the museum as a point of inspiration.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at approximately 9:45am and will get picked up from the Museum at 1.30pm Children will need to wear their school uniform and bring a coat. We will have our lunch at Peterborough Museum.

#### **Spring 1 – Food preparation**

As part of our Toys topic the children will be planning and then making a simple sandwich for a 'Teddy Bear's Picnic'. They will be thinking about hygiene and safety when undertaking food preparation and will also be using a range of equipment to make their sandwich.

This will link in with both our science learning about Animals Including Humans and PSHE work around keeping safe.

### **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April – Hamerton Zoo**

As part of our topic of, 'Animals including humans,' within our science work, the children will have the opportunity to visit the animal exhibits at Hamerton Zoo. They will take part in a workshop linked to animal groups and even be able to meet several of the animals.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9:30am and get picked up from the Zoo at 2:00pm. Children will need to wear their school uniform and bring a coat. We will have our lunch at Hamerton Zoo.

### **Autumn, Spring and Summer term – Seasonal changes local area walk**

Throughout the year we will be undertaking short walks around the local area. The focus of these walks will be to look at our local community and to also observe seasonal changes. The children will take part in discussions along the route and at school afterwards to compare changes that they see.
