YEAR 2 Enrichment programme

Year 2 have several extra curriculum events planned for the year. These events are to enhance your child's learning and we feel they are valuable part of the education we offer here at Hampton Hargate Primary School. These events have to be paid for from our school budget and your contributions are crucial to enabling us to continue to offer these events.

Monday 21st October – Local Walk

As part of our Geography, we will be learning all about our local area. We will be going for a walk looking specifically at human and physical features.

Friday 8th November – Trunk Theatre

Trunk Theatre will be coming in to school to perform an educational, fun show for the children all out of a trunk about The Great Fire of London.

The children are invited to come into school dressed up for the day.

Boys: A large plain shirt with a large collar and a belt or cord around the waist; a plain waistcoat, if you have one; and plain, dark, baggy trousers (such as track suit bottoms) tucked into long socks.

Girls: A plain shirt with a large collar; a long, preferably plain skirt; a plain waistcoat, if you have one; a plain white apron; flat, sturdy shoes; and a plain white head scarf.

Wednesday 4th December – New Theatre

Year 2 have an exciting opportunity to go to the New theatre and watch a performance of 'The Snowman and the Snowdog' performed by a Peterborough Youth orchestra and friends.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 12.45pm and get picked up from the theatre at 2.45pm.

Friday 13th December – CSK Hampton Church

As part of our RE learning, we will be walking to CSK Hampton church to learning all about Christingles and the importance of Christmas to Christians.

Thursday 9th January– JuniorSTEM

As part of our Computing and Design and Technology curriculum, the children will have the opportunity to take part in an exciting Lego Robotics workshop delivered by JuniorStem. The children will follow pictorial instructions and experiment with programming using the software Lego Wedo 2.0 software to create a moving robot.

Monday 10th February – Multi-skills Festival

Year 2 will be going to Hampton College to take part in a multi skills festival. These sports festivals are an excellent opportunity for the children to visit another setting, take part in activities that are slightly different to those undertaken in our usual PE lessons and to compete against children from other schools. This competition encourages team work and social interactions.

Spring term 2 - Woodgreen 'Let's Talk About Pets' Workshop

Woodgreen Pets Charity will be delivering an exciting workshop where we will learn all about the work that they do, the types of pets that they help and how we should look after any pets we have. They will then introduce us to 'Woody the toy dog' who will teach us what dogs like/don't like and how we can stay safe around them. This will link in with both our science learning about Animals Including Humans and PSHE work around keeping safe.

Spring 2 – Food tasting experience

As part of our Seaside topic and Design technology learning, children will be designing, making, tasting and evaluating fruit pictures. We will practise our skills of cutting, peeling, grating and try different fruits.

Friday 6th June - Woburn Safari Park

As part of our topic 'Sensational Safari' and our science learning, 'Living things and their habitats,' we will be going to Woburn Safari park. We will go on a guided tour of the safari park and take part in an African adventure workshop.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school promptly at 9:00am and leaving the Zoo at 3pm. Please note children will arrive back at school at approximately 4.15pm.

Children will need to wear their school uniform and bring a coat. We will have our lunch at Woburn Safari park
