YEAR 6 Enrichment

We would like to outline the extra-curricular trips and events for the children this year. These events are aimed at inspiring pupils and enhancing their learning. We believe passionately that they serve as an invaluable part of their education we offer at Hampton Hargate Primary School. These events are funded partly from our school budget but your contributions are crucial to enabling us to continue to offer them.

Autumn term 2024 – DT Make do and Mend

We are linking our DT work this term to our World War 2 topic and would like to children to use the skills learned through primary school to “make do and mend”. We will be asking pupils to bring in an item that can be adapted or repurposed. Examples include an item of clothing that could be made into a scarf or an old shirt that is converted into a bag. A pillowcase or an old clean sock are also good items to adapt. Sewing equipment will then be provided to allow us to complete our creations.

September 2024 - Paleoquest

Year 6 became palaeontologists for the day in an exciting dinosaur workshop. They had the chance to handle some real dinosaur fossils, and some spectacular replicas. Pupils were asked to consider how big the dinosaurs were, what they ate and what their world was like. Children looked at fossil records from different eras stretching over millions of years.

Monday 25th November 2024 – Hampton College Cross Country Race

Year 6 will have the chance to compete against children from other schools in Hampton in a Cross-Country race at Hampton College. We will walk over to the College at around 9am and return at around break time. Children will need to ensure they have their PE kits and a change of footwear in case the field is muddy.

November 28th or 29th 2024 – Stibbington World War 2 Evacuation Day

Linking with our World War 2 History topic we are taking the children to Stibbington to learn about life as an evacuee. This will include a guided tour around the village and finding out about where real-life evacuees were sent to stay in order to escape the dangers of the Blitz.

We would really like pupils to dress up as evacuees to get into the spirit of the day. If you are unable to do this, then normal school uniform should be worn. Please ensure that your child brings warm clothing, has appropriate footwear on and a waterproof coat in case it rains.

Coaches will leave at around 9.15am and we anticipate returning to school by around 3pm. The children will need a disposable packed lunch, a drink and snack on the day.

Children will either go on November 28th or 29th. We will notify you closer to the trip when your child is going.

February 13th 2025 – Peterborough Cathedral

Linking with our History of Peterborough History unit we will visit the city's most historic building. Children will explore the Saxon and Viking origins of the site before taking part in interactive activities focussed on how it was built and other notable moments in its history. This will include learning about why the Cathedral was damaged during the English Civil War. We will be leaving at around 9am and return in time for lunchtime. Children will be expected to wear school uniform for the trip.

Summer term 2025 – DT Mexican Feast

Linking with our Geography unit on Mexico, we are planning a feast of Mexican food. Using their knowledge of the region, children will plan, prepare and sample a range of traditional snacks.

Wb 19th May – Sports week

Children will take part in several different sporting activities. They will develop their physical abilities, learn new skills and show their team spirit. Furthermore, they will engage in competitive activities, whilst promoting health, safety and physical fitness.

June 2025 - First Aid Course - Flagship Partners (exact date to be confirmed)

In June, qualified first aiders will be visiting Year 6 to teach them some basic first aid skills. The workshop will provide our pupils with the knowledge and abilities to recognise a variety of first-aid situations, how to deal with them and how to summon help.

July 2025 - Production

Year 6 will put on their end of Year performance at the end of the summer term. This will be a memorable experience for the children as they showcase a range of different skills in front of their peers and parents. They will be immersed in acting, singing, dancing and dressing-up.
