YEAR 5 Enrichment Programme

Year 5 have several extra curriculum events in the Autumn, Spring and Summer term. These events are to enhance your child's learning and we feel that they are valuable part of the education we offer here at Hampton Hargate Primary School. These events have to be paid for from our school budget and your contributions are crucial to enabling us to continue to offer these events.

Wednesday 9th October 2024 – Black Country Living Museum

In Topic during Autumn term, we are studying the Victorians, and this trip is an opportunity to enhance and support the learning we will be carrying out in the classroom including a chance for the children to dress up as Victorian children to get into the spirit. This is an amazing experience for the children to get an insight as to what life was like in Victorian times and follow the real lives and stories of young people growing up in Black Country. It will provide great inspiration for children's creative writing and broaden their understanding of this time period. Further details in a separate letter attached.

Monday 21st October 2024 – Hampton College Sports Festival

In PE, we have been focusing on advancing our netball and basketball knowledge. During the sports festival, schools from the local area will come together for a Basketball and Netball tournament, the morning will be filled with fun and friendly competition. The children will have the chance to showcase their sporting talents and abilities, whilst developing key skills.

November 2024 – Local walk linked to our UK Study of Peterborough

During the autumn term, as part of their geography curriculum, the children will participate in a local walk designed to help them familiarise themselves with their community. This experience will provide a great opportunity for them to enhance their map-reading skills, learn about Ordnance Survey maps and grid references, and practice using an eight-point compass.

December 2024 – DT Food tasting experience

In DT, we are focusing on Great British Dishes. The children will research, design, and taste-test a range of traditional sweet and savoury foods that are characteristic of British cuisine. Additionally, they will look at the importance of food and how it contributes to the nation's identity. They will also have the chance to compare international cuisines, allowing them the chance to expand their knowledge of other cooking styles and traditions.

March 2025 - Production

Year 5 will be performing in their production in the Spring term. This will be a memorable experience for the children as they showcase a range of different skills in front of their peers and parents. They will be immersed in acting, singing, dancing and dressing-up.

Wednesday 30th April 2025 – National Space Centre in Leicester

We have booked a trip to the National Space Centre in April as part of our science curriculum. During the trip, the children will be exploring the various galleries in the Space Centre; this includes them having the opportunity to watch a Planetarium show.
