YEAR 3 AUTUMN, SPRING AND SUMMER TERM ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

Year 3 have several extra curriculum events this academic year. These events are to enhance your child's learning and we feel they are a valuable part of the education we offer here at Hampton Hargate Primary School. These events have to be paid for from our school budget and your contributions are crucial to enabling us to continue to offer these events.

12th September - Paleoquest Workshop

Year 3 had a visit from Dr Helen, a palaeontologist and geologist, who ran a workshop for us. She brought with her an impressive collection of various rocks, authentic dinosaur fossils, and several remarkable replicas for our exploration. During the workshop, we had a range of activities to complete. We identified a range of fossils, sorted shark's teeth, and examined different rocks, crystals, and gems using magnifying glasses. We excavated a Pteranodon skull fossil from a bed of sand and examined a model of a dinosaur skull. We even completed some observational drawings. It was an engaging experience that enriched our learning.

19th or 20th November - Visit to Flag Fen, Peterborough.

As part of our studies on Prehistoric Britain we have a trip planned to Flag Fen that will excite the imagination and bring the past to life. The children will be exploring the site, discovering some of its treasures and how our ancestors used natural materials for food, medicine and to make things. The children will also be taking on the role of an archaeologist, learning how to read and understand the information artefacts give us about life in prehistoric Peterborough. The children will get to handle prehistoric artefacts, make their own clay pot, discuss how people lived and hear stories of from this time.

December 2024- Y3 Production

Year 3 will be performing together at the end of the Autumn term. This will be a memorable experience for the children as they showcase a range of different skills in front of the rest of the school and their parents. They will be immersed in acting, singing and dancing. Always a great end to the first term.

25th March or 1st April - Visit to Hazard Alley, Milton Keynes

We are very excited about a trip we have planned to Hazard Alley Safety Centre in Milton Keynes. This opportunity links with our PSHE and Computing work on how to keep safe and be a good citizen.

During the visit the children will encounter a range of hazards giving them the chance to develop vital knowledge and strategies for how to stay safe. Children are grouped with a guide and visit twelve scenarios in turn to learn about aspects such as fire, water, rail, road, cycle and pedestrian safety, home, personal safety, bullying, and on-line safety. They will also have the opportunity to practise making a 999 call and to learn some emergency first aid. They will have the opportunity for role play and discussion and will gain knowledge, positive attitudes and behaviours around safety and citizenship.
