It is a fun morning which enables the children to perform with their class and to be an audience to other children who will be playing a variety of instruments. We will be travelling by coach to the event and will return to school in time for lunch.

5th December- Trip to Peterborough Cathedral

As part of our RE work this term about the true meaning of Christmas, we will be spending the day at Peterborough cathedral where we will be in small groups and work around a series of stations focusing on the main parts of the Christmas story;

- The Preparation – Advent
- The Announcement – The angel Gabriel visits Mary
- The Promises – The wise men
- The Journey – Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem
- The Message – the angels visit the shepherds on the hillside
- The Gift – Jesus is born

We will also create some artwork during our visit.

31st January - Roman workshop

As part of our Local Roman Study of Peterborough the children will be taking part in a workshop as part of Peterborough Museum's outreach. The children will discover the origins of Roman Peterborough and take part in a variety of activities which are designed to reflect life in the local Roman region around Durobrivae. Other local places include the Roman Fort, Castor Praetorium, Mill Hill and many more. They will be getting 'hands on' with real Roman artefacts, dress like a Roman and have a taste of Roman life.

March 2025 - Y4 Production

Year 4 will be performing together at the end of the Spring term. This will be a memorable experience for the children as they showcase a range of different skills in front of the rest of the school and their parents. They will be immersed in acting, singing and dancing. Always a great end to the first term.

Week Beginning 19th May – Sports week

Children will take part in several different sporting activities. They will develop their physical abilities, learn new skills and show their team spirit. Furthermore, they will engage in competitive activities, whilst promoting health, safety and physical fitness.
