- Attend Parents' Evenings and other discussions about my child's progress.
- Support my child at school, by talking to him or her about school, reading the school newsletters and attending as many school events as possible.
- Support the school in implementing its policy for behaviour.
- · Provide an appropriate PE kit.
- Ensure that social networking sites are not used to publish any malicious or inappropriate posts relating to the school, its pupils or staff and be aware that legal advice will be considered should this happen.
- Be respectful of my own behaviour and use of language while on or around the school site.
