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Fairtrade Fortnight started on Monday and as a Fairtrade school, we are recognising the unfair circumstances some farmers and workers experience in other parts of the world. We have taken a lot of time to learn about what it means to be Fairtrade, which has gained us our full Fairtrade status. Activities are being completed in each year group during these two weeks. Next week we will be having a Fairtrade 'divine' chocolate bar available every day that the children will have the opportunity to buy for £1 aimed at promoting a Fairtrade item that they may choose to buy in the future, helping the process of creating better working conditions for others. If your child would like to buy a chocolate bar during next week, they will need to bring £1 to school in a clearly labelled envelope and give it to their teacher until selected Year 6 children visit their classroom each day.

Winter Reading Challenge reminder

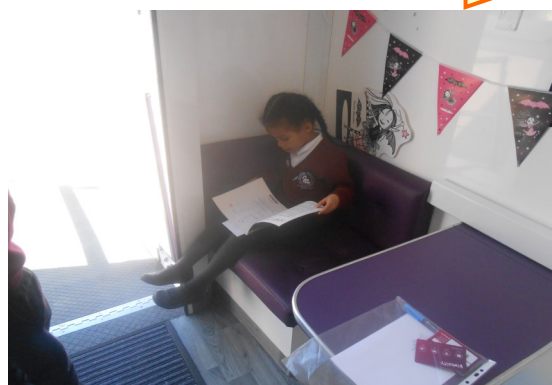
