Shoe Box Appeal

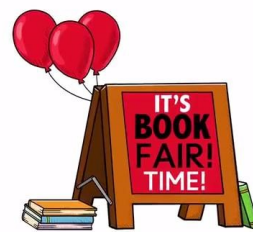

Every book purchased earns the school money to spend on books for the children to read at home. Last year we raised £1061 to spend on lovely new books.

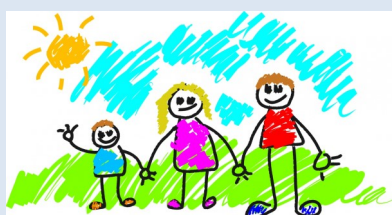
