# **Water Safety Visit**




This term we enjoyed an important assembly from the Canal and River Trust about Water Safety.

We looked at the risks and dangers of being around water and how we could support others when in trouble in the water.




# **Black History Month**








#### 17th – 21st October



As a school we are working towards the Dyslexia Quality Mark. Our philosophy is that changing practice to accommodate dyslexic individuals results in good practice for everyone.


